Christ is not just for Easter - the challenge is all year round and the journey is continuous, but we have Jesus walking alongside us thanks to His resurrection.

Looking ahead:

Taize Service Sunday 19th April: Anne is leading this as part of her training journey 6-7pm. A quiet reflective service for all ages. Taize is an ecumenical community in France which focuses on silence, prayer, songs and chants. It is easy to learn Taizé chants as they are repeated again and again, using just a few words. Refreshments will be served at the end of the service.

Pentecost - this is the festival when Christians celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit. It is celebrated on the Sunday 50 days after Easter (the name comes from the Greek pentekoste, "fiftieth").

Rogation Sunday - the fifth Sunday *after* Easter Sunday, a time for prayers for God's blessings on land, livestock and crops.

The Thursday following is the feast of the **Ascension**, which comes on a Thursday, the 40th day after Easter.

All will be celebrated, including a special Rogation Sunday walk and an Ascension day service from the top of the church tower! - watch this space for information!
